Dental Safety Net Programs Receive Big Boost from Delta Dental of Virginia Foundation

Annual Grant Program Increases Access to Oral Health Care and Education for Underserved Virginians

ROANOKE, Va. (Feb. 12, 2018) – The Delta Dental of Virginia Foundation has awarded \$370,500 in grants to support 40 organizations committed to improving oral health across the Commonwealth.

The grants were awarded to tax-exempt organizations whose work will improve the oral health of uninsured or under-insured Virginians through education and access to care. (Full list of grant recipients below.)

"Delta Dental believes in the power of a healthy smile and the importance of oral health to overall health and well-being," said Frank Lucia, president and CEO of Delta Dental of Virginia. "We are proud to partner with these wonderful organizations to improve the lives of so many Virginians."

The foundation has provided more than \$4.2 million in funding to 63 organizations over the past six years. Founded in 2012 with an initial \$2.5 million donation from Delta Dental of Virginia, the foundation provides grants to Virginia not-for-profit organizations with a focus on community-based safety-net programs.

Many of the grants awarded focus on key areas of need throughout Virginia – the state's youth, the uninsured and medically underserved population and dental professionals in training. The foundation partners with community organizations such as the Boys & Girls Clubs to provide oral health care and education to children who lack dental insurance or who qualify for Medicaid or Family Access to Medical Insurance Security (FAMIS).

Organizations eligible to receive grants from the Delta Dental of Virginia Foundation include governmental agencies or educational institutions, entities holding a 501(c)(3) tax-exemption, or organizations with a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt fiscal sponsor.
